ETIQUETTE

CONSIDERATION FOR OTHER PLAYERS

A player should be allowed to play before their opponent or fellow competitor tees their ball.

No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke. Slow play is a scourge and encourages people to take up bowls. Remember our place in the field is just behind the group ahead and not just in front of the group behind.

In the interest of all, players should play without delay, walk briskly between shots towards your ball and be ready to play when it is your turn. Slow play is a distraction to most players. Taking a practice swing is encouraged but taking numerous practice swings must be discouraged. The lowest handicapper in a group is responsible for the speed of play.

No player should play until the players in front are out of range however higher handicap players are encouraged to play out of turn if they are unable to reach the players ahead.

In Stableford and Par events, pick up your ball as soon as you are unable to score on a hole. When you come to the green put your bag, off the green, between the flag and the path to the next tee.

Players searching for a ball should signal the players behind them to pass as soon as it becomes apparent that the ball will not easily be found. They should not search for five minutes before doing so. They should not continue play until the players following them have passed and are out of range.

When the play of a hole has been completed players should immediately leave the putting green and mark their cards while waiting to play their shot on the next tee. The player with the honor on the tee should mark their card after playing their tee shot.

We play for vouchers – not sheep stations. Saving a minute on each hole means your game is 20 minutes faster.

PRIORITY ON THE COURSE

In the absence of special rules, two-ball matches should have precedence over, and be entitled to pass any three or four ball match. A single player has no standing and should give way to a match of any kind.

Any match playing a whole round is entitled to pass a match playing a shorter round.

If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front, it should allow the match following to pass.

CARE OF THE COURSE

Members are requested to accept responsibility to see that all players; public as well as other members, observe the necessary requirements for conduct, preservation and maintenance of the course. All players must carry a sand bucket and repair all divots through the green. The course staff have right of way at all times.

CARE OF THE COURSE *(Continued)*

Do not wheel golf buggies on to the putting greens or tees. Before leaving a bunker, smooth over all holes and footprints made and leave the rake in the bunker facing the direction of play. Replace all divots and repair pitch marks.

Repair damage to the green caused by golf shoe spikes on completion of the hole.

Ensure no damage is done to the green when laying down bags or flag sticks.

Avoid damage to the green by not leaning on your putter as you retrieve the ball.

In taking practice swings, players should avoid damaging the course and in particular the tees.

Golf carts must not be driven dangerously or through muddy areas.

DRESS REGULATIONS

In order to maintain a standard suitable to the club, members are requested to pay attention to their dress. The following should be regarded as a minimum.

Men.

1. An acceptable golf shirt (as sold in the pro shop) must be worn.
2. Slacks, dress jeans or tailored shorts are allowed.
3. Socks must be worn with shorts, they may be calf or ankle length.
4. Suitable closed in footwear must be worn.

The following are not permitted:- short shorts, tracksuits, football socks and jumpers, board shorts or beach shorts, sandals or thongs.

Ladies.

1. Neat golf attire must be worn at all times.
2. An acceptable golf shirt (as sold in the pro shop) must be worn.
3. Skirts, culottes, slacks, knickerbockers and tailored Track pants made as slacks.

The following are not permitted: - Short shorts, tank tops, sun tops, bare midriff tops, track suits and jeans.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The Code of Conduct applies to amateur golfers and caddies, in all Championships, major activities, events, representative team members playing away from home, competitions and clubhouse activities conducted by Russell Vale Golf and Social Club. It is in addition to any other requirements of Players and Caddies as set out in tournament conditions, local rules or by-laws of clubs hosting Russell Vale Golf and Social Club events.

Each Player or Caddie in a competition must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. In order to ensure proper standards of behaviour during a competition a Player or Caddie, who commits an offence under this Code will face disciplinary proceedings.

Copies of the Code of conduct are available from the Office and a copy is available on the Web Site.

MEMBERSHIP

INTERMEDIATE MEMBERSHIP

Youth members are members whose age is between 18 to 24 years old. They become ordinary members on their 25th birthday.

JUNIOR MEMBERS

Junior members are members whose age is between 12 and 17 years old. They become Intermediate members on their 18th birthday.

CADET MEMBERS

Cadet members are members whose age is between 7 and 11 years old. They become junior members on their 12th birthday

PENSIONER.

A pensioner member is a person who is a holder of a valid pensioner concession card. They are entitled to all ordinary member privileges.

ORDINARY MEMBERS

Ordinary members both male and female are all members over 25 years of age.

SOCIAL MEMBERS

Social members are members who are non-playing members. They do not have all the privileges of ordinary members.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

for Russell Vale Golf and Social Club

The following conditions, in concert with those contained in specific entry forms and any other additions or amendments as published.

1) **Eligibility:**

a) The Match Committee shall have the power to vary these conditions and to decide any dispute or question arising as to the qualification of any entrant and may, in its absolute discretion at any time and without assigning any reason therefore, refuse any entrant ineligible to compete. Players should determine their eligibility for a particular event prior to the entry of the event.

b) In the event of a player being suspended by an affiliated club, a club affiliated with a District Golf Association or a District Golf Association on a golf related matter the player shall not be eligible to enter or play in any event during the period of suspension.

2) **Match Committee:** The members of the Match Committee present during the playing of an event may exercise all functions of the Match Committee in relation to the event and shall constitute the Committee within the meaning of the Rules of Golf for the purpose of the conduct of the event. Play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf and Local Rules.

3) **Returning of Score Card:** A player's score is deemed officially returned to the Committee when the player has posted his card into the designated card return box in the clubhouse.

4) **Protests:** Protests or disputes in connection with any competition or match must be made in writing and submitted to the Match Committee within fifteen (15) minutes of the conclusion of the day's play.

5) **Entry to Events:** The openings for each competition play will start two (2) weeks prior to the competition day. Booking your name in for each competition day can be made at the Clubhouse starting at 8am for Tuesday and Thursday and for Saturday competition, bookings commence at 5pm Friday. Bookings can also be made via the internet starting 12pm Tuesday and Thursday and 8 am Saturday. One person is able to enter up to four (4) names

6) **Starting Times:** Rule 6-3a provides that the player(s) shall start at the time laid down by the committee. The penalty for breach of rule 6.3a is disqualification. However, if a player arrives at their starting point ready to play, within five (5) minutes after the starting time, the penalty for failing to start on time is loss of the first hole in match play or two (2) strokes at the first hole in stroke play instead of disqualification. The Match Committee reserves the right to fix and/or alter starting times.

7) **Practice:** During practice or during the playing of an event the player shall not place on the course or cause to be placed on the course any artificial marker designed to indicate course measurements. A player in breach of this condition shall be disqualified.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION *(Continued)*

- 8) **Pace of Play:** Each group shall maintain its position on the course with respect to the group in front. In the absence of mitigating circumstances a group will be out of position and may be subject to penalty if they are more than the starting interval behind the group in front. Penalties MAYBE issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

- 9) **Suspension Of Play:** These signals will apply:
- Suspend play – three (3) short consecutive notes of the siren repeated.
 - Resume play – one (1) prolonged note of the siren repeated.
- 10) **Cancellation:** Player's who are unable to compete for any reason, should cancel by contacting the starter during business hours on phone number (02) 4283 5322 or via the internet before 06:00 AM on the day of competition. Failure to do so could result in a penalty of suspension for a period of time.
- 11) **Results of the Competition** - Competition closed: The competition is closed by announcement from the Match Committee, normally 15 minutes after the completion of play. Score cards returned after this time will not be considered for inclusion in the event.
- 12) **Determination of Ties:** The winner of ties will be decided on the score for the last nine holes. If a ties still exists the winner of the last 6 holes and then the winner of the last 3 holes and then the last hole. If a tie still exists the winner will be decided on a hole by hole basis from the 18th hole. If players are still tied after this procedure they will be declared joint winners of the competition.
- 13) **Championship Events:** to win a major prize (gross / net) in a club championship members must return Five (5) live Russell Vale single competition handicap cards within twelve (12) months prior to the commencement of such club championship.
- 14) **Transportation:** Automotive locomotion during the play is permitted except in conditions where it is considered the use of such devices will result in undue damage to the course.
- 15) **By-Laws, Rules and Dress Regulation:** The by-laws, rules and dress regulations of Russell Vale Golf and Social Club shall apply. The penalty for non-compliance shall be no start or disqualification.
- 16) **Alcohol:** The consumption of alcohol on the Golf Course is strictly prohibited, except for events where the appropriate licence under the Liquor Act 2007 has been obtained and approved by Wollongong City Council.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION *(Continued)*

- 17) **Mobile Phones.** The use of a mobile phone or portable phone by a competitor or his caddie, whilst on the golf course during an event is distracting and inconsiderate. If the competitor or caddie is in the possession of a mobile or portable phone it should be turned off. If the phone rings this is deemed to be in use and the committee may take disciplinary action against the offending player in accordance with the concluding paragraph of section 1, Etiquette of the Rules of Golf. If a mobile phone has a distance measuring device facility it may be used in line with Condition 7, provided the device does not have the facility to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc). However the 'phone communication' facility of the mobile phone should be turned off. In match play, the opponent should be informed if the player plans to use this facility

- a) The Board: Means the Russell Vale Golf and Social Club Ltd.
 - b) The Match Committee: Means the Match Committee of the Russell Vale Golf and Social Club Ltd.
 - c) Recognised Golf Club: Means a golf club

GUIDELINES FOR THE PREVENTION OF SLOW PLAY

The Committee has determined that the maximum time allowed for the completion of 18 holes during a round played in groups of four is 3 hours 30 minutes. Each hole has been given a completion time based upon the length and difficulty of the hole, a schedule is shown below. In the event of severe weather conditions the times may need to be adjusted. Check points have been incorporated at the completion of the 9th and 18 holes (flagstick in the hole). A group is out of position when it completes the hole later than the time scheduled.

Members can minimise round times by adopting the following:

- Be Aware of your position with regard to the group in front.
- Do not concern yourself with the group behind, the fact that you are not holding them up is irrelevant as it is your group's responsibility to keep up with the group in front.
- If you feel that your group is falling behind, advise the other players in your group
- If your group is behind, try to catch up quickly.
- If you lose a clear hole and are delaying the group behind, invite the group behind to play through.
- Do not wait until it is your turn to play before putting your glove on.
- Do not wait until it is your turn before calculating your yardage and selecting your club.
- Look at your own line of putt while the other players in the group look at theirs and putt.(within the bounds of normal etiquette)
- At the green position your golf bag/buggy so as to allow quick movement from the green to the next tee.
- Play a provisional ball if your ball may be lost in a hazard or out of bounds.

GUIDELINES FOR THE PREVENTION OF SLOW PLAY *(Continued)*

- If you keep up with the group in front, you cannot be accused of slow play.

Remember there are penalties for a breach of the slow play regulations.

Tee Times

The starting times allow the club to start 200 players in our Saturday competition. There will be times when we do not have 200 players so the Club has had to come to arrangement with Wollongong City Council which allows our members to have precedence on the course, while also allowing public access on Saturdays. Members should understand that for the course to prosper and generate funds it must be utilised at all possible times.

COMPETITIONS

Eagles Nest

Men's

The men's eagle nest is played on the 9th hole on Saturday single events only. Players tee shots must be within 60 cm of the hole to win. If more than one winner the nest shall be divided equally among the players involved.

Ladies

The ladies eagle nest is played on the 12th hole on Tuesday single events only. Players tee shots must be within 90 cm of the hole to win. If more than one winner the nest shall be divided equally among the players involved.

Visitors playing in our club events are not eligible to win the eagles nest.

COMPETITIONS *(Continued)*

Longest Drive

The ladies and men's longest drive competition is played on monthly medal days only on the 14th fairway. Players record their names on the relevant markers for their division or grade.

Drive and Pitch

Ladies and men's competitions are held on the 8th and 18th holes respectively and do not apply to foursomes and ambrose events. Distance from the hole to be recorded on the green side markers provided. The hole and distance should also be recorded on the scorecard.

Nearest the Pin

Competitions are conducted on holes at the discretion of the Match and Handicap Committee. Distances are recorded on the relevant greenside markers. The hole and distance should also be recorded on the scorecard.

Eclectic Competitions

1. Men's and Junior's Eclectic Competition

This competition applies to Saturday single competitions between the start of February to the end of December. In the event of a tie a count back will be conducted on the last card received.

2. Ladies Eclectic Competition

There are two Eclectic competitions for Lady members.

- a.) A Saturday eclectic competition applying to single events running from the beginning of February to mid- December.
- b.) A Tuesday eclectic competition applying to single events running from the beginning of February to mid- December.
In the event of a tie a count back will be conducted on the last cards received.

Monthly Medals

Men

Monthly medals are conducted for three grades and juniors on the first Saturday of the month. The winners of the monthly medals in a calendar year qualify to participate in the gold medal playoff held on the first Saturday of December. Monthly medal and gold medal events are net stroke events. Veteran monthly medals are conducted on the first Thursday of each month. Winners of the vet's medals qualify to play the gold medal event on the first Saturday of December.

Ladies

The ladies monthly medals are conducted on the first Saturday of the month and the second Tuesday of the month. The gold medal playoff is held on the second Tuesday of December.

Grades for Competitions

In all club championship events and Monthly Medals there will be three grades for men and two divisions for ladies. The handicap limits for the grades and divisions will be determined by the Match and Handicap Committee.

In all other events grades and divisions will be decided by the Match and Handicap Committee dependent on numbers.

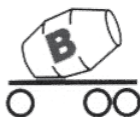
