



Conditions of Play

Men's, Ladies and Junior Single Matchplay

In addition to Russell Vale Golf and Social Club's standard Local Rules and Conditions of Play, the following conditions shall apply.

Eligibility

This event is restricted to members of Russell Vale Golf Club. Entry is subject to Clause 12 of the Russell Vale Golf Club Standard Local Rules and Conditions of Play.

Entries

Booking in the Championship is via nomination sheets placed on the notice board. The close of nominations will be included on the nomination sheet.

Schedule for Play

The date for the completion of each round will be posted on the notice board along with the draw. It is the responsibility of all players to arrange and play their matches by the posted dates. The results of completed matches should be posted on the day to enable following matches to proceed

Matches not completed by the due date will result in the disqualification of one or both players. The Match & Handicap Committee will consider written applications for a variance to this before the due date, such applications may result in one of the contestants being reinstated to the event. This will be dependent on the application as judged by the Committee and will not be subject to appeal.

Handicaps

- Men

The number of strokes given is the full daily handicap difference. Where the full handicap difference exceeds 18, players will receive a maximum of 1 stroke per hole where

applicable. When additional holes are required to determine the winner, strokes are awarded on the same holes as in the original round.

The International Stroke Play index shall be used for determination for strokes given at each hole.

- Ladies

The number of strokes given is the full daily handicap difference. Where the full handicap difference exceeds 18, players will receive a maximum of 1 stroke per hole.

The Ladies Matchplay index is to be used for determination of strokes given at each Hole.

- Juniors

Handicaps used is the Daily Handicap. Where the full handicap difference exceeds 18 payers will receive 2 or 3 strokes per hole where applicable.

Any girl playing on the day will have her daily handicap adjusted according to the formula:-
Girl's Daily handicap = Daily handicap + (Scr Rating Women's course – Scr Rating Men's course). There will be no adjustment to tee positions. When the match comprises two girls, there is no handicap adjustment due to this situation.

The JNJG Stroke Play index shall be used for determination for strokes given at each hole.

Resolution of ties.

There will be no tied matches, matches tied after 18 holes will continue to play until a hole is won. Any strokes given on the first 18 holes will apply on corresponding holes.

Play conducted within a normal club event.

Players wishing to combine match Play and Stroke play should make the committee aware of their intentions.

The Rules of Golf would apply to each of match play and stroke play separately. For example, if one player did not complete a hole for whatever reason then he or she is disqualified from the stroke-play competition for a breach of [Rule 3.3c](#). But, for Stableford, and Par/Bogey see [Rules 21.1c\(2\)](#), [21.2c](#) and [21.3c\(2\)](#) respectively.
