The Ladies Foursome Championship will be held on over two rounds on dates decided by the Match and Handicap Committee.

Eligibility.

Eligible players are as per Clause 13 of the Russell Vale Golf Club Standard Conditions and Local Rules.

Mode of Play.

- Play will be in Sixes.
- Play be off the red daily markers of the day.
- Play from the first tee will start with player 1 on the score card will be reversed for the second round.

Please note:

- If either player incurs a penalty stroke it does not alter the rotation of play. This includes the playing of a provisional ball. If a man hits a tee shot out of bounds, then His lady partner must hit the next shot from the men's tee.

Handicaps.

Ladies playing handicap is a of a maximum of 45.

Scoring.

Scoring is as for a stroke round and the total gross score subject to a deduction of half the aggregate handicaps for the nett winners.

Ties.

In the event of a tie for the Championship the winners will be decided by a sudden death playoff commencing at the tenth hole followed by the 11th hole if needed. Players will then repeat these holes until a result is reached. All other tied results will stand.
